




ACTIVITY OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS¹

IN FEBRUARY 2012

In February 2012 1 681 accommodation establishments - hotels, motels, camping sites, mountain chalets and other establishments for short-term accommodation with more than 10 bed places were functioned in the country (Table 1). The total number of the rooms in them was 51.2 thousands and the bed-places were 102.1 thousands. In comparison with the previous month the total numbers of accommodation establishments as well as the bed-places in them increased by 1.4 and 2.6% respectively.

The total number of the nights spent in all accommodation establishments amounted to 572.8 thousand or by 6.6% less compared to the previous month. The nights spent in accommodation establishments with 3 or 4 and 5 stars decreased by 2.6 and 15.4% respectively, while in these with 1 and 2 stars rose by 8.5%. The nights spent by Bulgarian residents in all accommodation establishments increased by 6.3% and reached 330.0 thousands, while the nights spent by foreigners dropped by 19.9% to 242.8 thousands.

Figure 1. The nights spent in accommodation establishments by categories in January and February 2012




¹ Since January 2012 the survey on accommodation establishments has been carried out monthly in compliance with the Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism and the Regulation 1051/2011 of the Commission implementing Regulation 692/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning European statistics on tourism, as regards the structure of the quality reports and the transmission of the data.



The arrivals in all accommodation establishments increased by 3.6% and reached 234.2 thousands. The relative share of the arrivals of Bulgarians was 65.7% from whole arrivals as the main part (71.2%) of them spent the nights in hotels 1, 2 or 3 stars and spent 2.1 nights on the average. The arrivals of foreigners were 75 thousands and decreased by 18%. Almost all foreigners preferred to spend the nights in the hotels as 71.4% of them spent nights in hotels with 4 and 5 stars. On the average 3.3 nights were spent by foreigners.


Figure 2. Arrivals in accommodation establishments by categories in February 2012



In February the total occupancy of the bed-places in accommodation establishments was 20.6% as the highest it was in 4 and 5 stars accommodation establishments - 31.5%, followed by these with 3 stars - 19.4%. The lowest occupancy in accommodation establishments was observed in 1 and 2 stars - 13.1%. An increase in the occupancy of the bed-places with 3 stars and with 1 and 2 stars by 1.6 and 1.0 percentage points respectively was registered in comparison with the previous month, while these with 4 and 5 stars it decreased by 0.5 percentage points.

The total revenues from nights spent reached 27.6 million BGN or by 6.6% less compared to the previous month. A decrease by 13.6% in the revenues from the foreigners was registered, while the revenues from Bulgarians increased by 0.4%.



Methodological notes

In the statistical survey of accommodation establishments were included all categorized hotels, camping sites and other type of accommodation establishments with more than 10 bed-places in use during the reporting period.

The indicator other accommodation establishments contained the holiday settlements, hostels, guests houses, bungalows, rest houses, mountain chalets, private rooms and flats and other establishments for short accommodation.
