

TRIPS OF BULGARIAN RESIDENTS ABROAD AND ARRIVALS OF VISITORS FROM ABROAD TO BULGARIA IN AUGUST 2012

In August 2012 **the number of the trips of Bulgarian residents abroad** was 412.9 thousand or by 2.1% more than in July 2012 and by 3.8% above the registered in August 2011 (Figure 1). An increase in the total number of the trips of Bulgarian residents compared to the same month of the previous year was reported to: Italy - by 145.2%, Austria - by 131.4%, Spain - by 72.3%, the United Kingdom - by 58.6%, Germany - 45.6% and etc. At the same time a decrease was observed to: Greece – by 32.5%, Serbia - by 8.0% and Turkey - by 7.6% (Annex, Table 1).

The trips with other purposes (as guest, education and visit the cultural and sport events) composed the greatest share of the total number of trips of Bulgarian residents abroad - 43.6%, followed by the trips with holiday and recreation purposes - 38.8% and with professional purpose - 17.6%. In comparison with August 2011 an increase was observed in the trips with holiday and recreation purpose, as well as these with other purposes rose by 48.4% and 30.2% respectively, while a decrease in the trips with professional purposes was registered - by 52.1%.

In August 2012 the trips with other purposes formed 67.6% from all trips to Serbia, 50.4% - to Germany, 44.8% - to Greece. Predominated share of the trips to Turkey and France was with holiday and recreation purpose - 49.7 and 49.4% respectively, while to Belgium and Russia they were connected with professional purpose - 47.4 and 41.0% respectively of all trips of Bulgarian residents to these countries (Figure 2).

In August 2012, **the number of arrivals of visitors from abroad to Bulgaria** was 1 637.8 thousand which was by 2.7% less compared to July 2012 and by 3.3% above the level from August 2011 (Figure 3). An increase in the visit by all observed purposes was registered, as the greatest was the growth in the visits with professional purpose - by 22.0%, followed by these with other purposes - by 3.4%, and with holiday and recreation purpose - by 2.0%.

The visits of the citizens of European Union composed the greatest relative share of the total number of foreigners visited Bulgaria - 64.3%, followed by these from the other European countries - 28.3% (Annex, Table 2). In comparison with the same month of the previous year the arrivals of visitors from EU Member States decreased by 3.8%. A significant decrease was observed in the visits of the citizens from Spain - by 17.1%, Denmark - by 14.7%, Germany - by 12.5%, Italy - by 5.4% and the United Kingdom - by 5.0%. However a growth in the visits from Greece - by 2.8%, Belgium - by 1.7%, Romania - by 1.1% and Austria - by 1.0% was registered.

The visits of foreigners in the group "Other European countries"¹ increased by 23.3% as the highest growth was observed from Turkey, Ukraine and Russian Federation citizens - by 47.2, 40.5 and 34.1% respectively.

In August 2012 the predominated share of the total number of the visits to Bulgaria were with holiday and recreation purpose - 62.8%, followed by the arrivals with other purposes (including as guest and passing transit) - 32.2% and with professional purpose - 5.0%.

The visits with holiday and recreation purpose formed 87.2% of the arrivals from Russia, 83.3% - from the United Kingdom, 81.5% - from FYROM and 80.8% - from Ukraine. The visits with professional purpose

www.nsi.bg were 14.9% of all arrivals from Italy, while with other purpose were 85.7% of the arrivals from Turkey and 43.7% - from Austria (Figure 4).







Methodological notes

Statistical data on the trips of Bulgarian citizens travelling abroad and visits by foreigners in Bulgaria are obtained on the basis of monthly information received from the Ministry of Interior and sample survey of the National Statistical Institute among Bulgarian and foreign citizens passing the border check points.

Data on the number of the trips of the citizens of the European Union are estimated on the basis of the information obtained from the Ministry of Interior and the airport authorities. Data on the number of citizens of "third countries" are obtained directly from the Ministry of Interior.

Data on the purposes of the trips are developed on the basis of the NSI's regular monthly sample survey of passing Bulgarian and foreign citizens on the border check points.
