


GOODS AND PASSENGERS CARRIED AND TRANSPORT PERFORMANCE BY MODE OF TRANSPORT

1. Land transport

1.1 Freight transport

In the first quarter of 2009 the goods carried were by 35.3% less as compared to the previous quarter, due to decreased volume of the national carriages.


Transport performance in tkm for the same period was reduced by 15.2% and reached 4357.6 million tkm. As compared to the same quarter of the previous year, goods carried in the first quarter of 2009 decreased by 32.7%, while the transport performance – by 15.3%.



1.2 Passenger transport

Passengers carried by land transport were by 7.4% less compared to the previous quarter and by 7.9% less compared to the first quarter of 2008. A drastic drop was observed in international carriages – by 62.1% in comparison with the previous quarter and by 52.2% in comparison with the first quarter of the previous year, but due to their low percentage from the total passengers carried, they did not effect essentially the trend as a whole.

A decrease trend was is also observed in transport performance (in passenger-km) - respectively by 27.3% as compared to the previous quarter and by 24.3% as compared to the corresponding quarter of the previous year.




2. Water transport

2.1 Freight transport

Goods carried by the water transport during the first quarter of 2009 dropped by 37.3% and the transport performance (in tkm) - by 53.1% in comparison with the same quarter of 2008.


For the period January – March of 2009, the decrease in relation to the previous three months of 2008 is respectively 25.8% for the goods carried 67.8% for the transport performance (in tkm) .



2.2 Passenger transport

Passenger carried during the first quarter of 2009 increased by 4.5% as compared to the previous quarter, but as compared to first quarter of 2008, there is a decrease by 2.1%.

Passengers carried and transport performance are composed entirely of the IWW international carriages by ferries.



3. Urban electrical transport

According to data of the enterprises performing passengers transport by urban electrical means, the number of the passengers carried in the first quarter of this year is 70724 thousand, which is 7.8% lessening as compared to the previous quarter and 10.8% lessening as compared to the first quarter of 2008.

Transport performance (in passenger-km) decrease is 11.6% in comparison with the fourth quarter of the previous year, and 16.9% as compared to the first quarter of 2008, which is a result of the reduced Average distance travelled in the urban electrical carriages.
