




## BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDINGS STARTED IN THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2019

In the third quarter of 2019, the municipal authorities issued **building permits** for construction of 1 630 residential buildings with 9 018 dwellings and 1 110 322 sq. m gross building area, of 23 administrative buildings/offices with 58 419 sq. m gross building area and 1 188 other buildings with 694 726 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter the issued building permits for residential buildings increased by 2.5%, the number of their dwellings - by 6.6% and the gross building area - by 3.0%. The issued building permits of administrative buildings fell by 25.8% and their gross building area - by 6.0%. The issued building permits of other buildings registered a growth by 1.7% and their gross building area - by 18.0%.

Figure 1. Building permits issued for construction of new buildings by type and quarter








As compared to the third quarter of 2018 the issued building permits for new residential buildings decreased by 1.7%, their dwellings - by 4.3% and the gross building area - by 5.4%. The number of issued building permits of administrative buildings and their gross building area registered a drop by 37.8% and 72.5% respectively. The issued building permits for other buildings fell by 1.6% and their gross building area - by 1.8%.

The highest number of building permits for new residential buildings was issued in the following districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 263, Varna - 203, Plovdiv - 187, Sofia - 132 and Blagoevgrad - 111. Most dwellings are to be built in the districts: Sofia (stolitsa) - 3 839, Varna - 1 385, Plovdiv - 859, Burgas - 646 and Kardzhali - 521 (Annex, Table 1).





In the third quarter of 2019 **began the construction** of 1 156 residential buildings with 7 021 dwellings and 908 670 sq. m gross building area, of 13 administrative buildings/offices with 12 301 sq. m gross building area and of 666 other buildings with 390 746 sq. m gross building area.

As compared to the previous quarter the started residential buildings decreased by 3.9%, but their dwellings rose by 24.3% as well as the gross building area - by 25.2%. The number of started administrative buildings and their gross building area registered a drop by 45.8% and 58.9% respectively. The started other buildings increased by 7.1%, while their gross building area fell by 14.7%.





Figure 3. Started construction of new buildings by type and quarter

As compared to the third quarter of 2018 the started new residential buildings rose by 11.4%, their dwellings - by 18.6% and their gross building area - by 36.2%. The number of started administrative buildings fell by 55.2% and their gross building area - by 84.9%. The started other buildings increased by 4.4%, while their gross building area decreased by 12.9%.

The construction of the highest number of new buildings were started in the following districts: Plovdiv - 200 residential buildings and 67 other buildings; Sofia (stolitsa) - 198 residential buildings, 3 administrative buildings and 28 other buildings; Varna - 138 residential buildings and 37 other buildings; Sofia - 83 residential buildings and 51 other buildings; Stara Zagora - 58 residential buildings and 61 other buildings (Annex, Table 2).





## Methodological notes

The quarterly statistical survey of permits issued for construction collects information about building permits, issued by municipal authorities as well as for the started construction of new buildings according to their type and gross building area. This information may be used as an indicator of future construction activity of enterprises in the country.

**Type of buildings** is classified according to the Classification of types of construction (CC) and is divided into:

- Residential buildings for which the useful floor area is mostly used for permanent residential habitation.
- Non-residential buildings for various purposes, including:
- administrative offices and buildings for administrative work of departments and other organizations and associations (representative buildings banks, post offices, government department offices, conference and congress centres, low courts, municipalities);
- other buildings buildings used for different activities: production, trade, transport, education, cultural, sports, agriculture, health, recreation and facilities for short stay (hotels, motels, rest houses, huts and others).

**Gross building area -** a sum of all floors areas in external dimensions.
