



# PUBLISHING PRODUCTION IN 2019 (PUBLISHED BOOKS AND PAMPHLETS AND CONTINUING EDITIONS)

The National Statistical Institute annual publishes data for issued books and pamphlets, continued editions (newspapers, magazines, bulletins and periodicals) and for electronic publications. Source of information is the 'St. St. Cyril and Methodius' National Library and the main indicators are in accordance to the methodological requirements of UNESCO.


## **Published Books and Pamphlets**

In 2019 were published 8 604 books with circulation of 6 325 046 and 912 pamphlets with circulation of 1 302 728 (Table 1).

## 1. Published books and pamphlets in 2019

With the unique identification code ISBN (International Standard Book Number) in 2019 were registered 8 207 books and 874 pamphlets, or 95.4% of all editions, which provided an opportunity for commercial use in the country and abroad.

<sup>1</sup> The total circulation to the number of published books and pamphlets.






In comparison with the previous year in 2019 the number of published books and pamphlets decreased by 326 (3.3%) and the average circulation from 1 144 to 802 or by 29.9%.

According the characteristic 'Target groups'<sup>1</sup> (thematic areas) the distribution of editions by sections in 2019 was following:

- Scientific literature 2 972 titles with circulation of 567 thousands;
- Fiction for adults 2 146 titles with circulation of 1 181 thousands;
- Educational literature 1 743 titles with circulation of 3 783 thousands;
- Popular literature 1 387 titles with circulation of 930 thousands;
- Children's and Juvenile literature 870 titles with circulation of 826 thousands, of which Children fiction literature was presented with 513 titles with circulation of 459 thousands;
- Other 398 titles with circulation of 341 thousands.

# Figure 2. Published titles of books and pamphlets by thematic areas according to the characteristic 'Target groups' in 2019




In 2019 the titles published of the original language of writing (including in Bulgarian language) were 7 571 titles, or 79.6% of the total number of published books and pamphlets. The titles of translated publications were 1 945 with circulation of 1 561 thousands. Of which more than half of the translated literature was from English (55.8%), followed by the translated editions from French - 7.0%, German - 6.4% and Russian - 6.1%. (Figure 3).

# Published Continuing Editions (Newspapers and Periodicals)




Figure 4. Published newspapers by titles and annual circulation for the period 2010 - 2019

In 2019 were published 223 newspapers with an annual circulation of 169 261 thousands and in comparison with the previous year published newspapers decreased by 16 titles (6.7%) and their circulation decreased by 46 776 thousands (21.7%) (Figure 4).






# Figure 5. Issued newspapers (titles and annual circulation) by periodicity in 2019

Periodicity with the biggest circulation in 2019 was daily newspapers - 88 443 thousand (Figure 5).

In 2019 the highest number of newspapers was published in Sofia (stolitsa) district - 108 titles or 48.4% of all published newspaper in the country (Figure 6).









With the highest relative share according to the characteristic 'Target group - serials'<sup>1</sup> were the editions from thematic area 'Political, philosophical, religious and cultural issues' - 51.6% (115 titles) as their annual circulation was 67 663 thousands.

98% (218 titles) of all newspapers published in 2019 were in Bulgarian language and in foreign languages were five - two in Turkish and by one in Russian, English and German.

In 2019 were published 505 magazines and 90 bulletins and in comparison with 2018 the number of the magazines decreased by 4.7% and the number of bulletins increased by 16.9% (Table 2).


In 2019 were published 83 magazines and bulletins in foreign languages with an annual circulation of 245 thousands. The most numerous publications were in English - 76 titles with circulation of 200 thousands, followed by two editions in German, and by one title in French, Turkish, Spanish, Esperanto and one in two or more languages.

According to the magazines periodicity with the biggest annual circulation in 2019 were the monthly magazines with 4 602 thousand (Figure 7).

In 2019 were published also 140 periodic collections with circulation of 22 thousands and compared to 2018 their number increased by 42 titles and their circulation by 21.6%.







#### **Methodological notes**

The survey of publishing activity is annual and covers the activity of public and private publishers and editorials. The data are provided to NSI by the 'St. St. Cyril and Methodius' National Library (all deposited publications for the year).

The number of books and pamphlets do not include publications with closely departmental purpose, with temporary and advertising character, with a circulation of less than 100 copies and capacity less than four pages.

**Pamphlets** is non-periodical printed publication with at least five but not more than 48 pages, published in the country and made available to the public.

**Book** is non-periodical issued printed document with at least 49 pages, published in the country and made available to the public.

**Title -** word or set of words, usually marked on the document, for using identification and often (but not always) distinguish it from other documents.

**Volume** - a physical unit of a printed document that contains fixed number of pages bound together in one and represents a whole or part of a set.

Circulation is the total number of publications, printed from a single title.

**Serial** - document in print or non-print form, issued in successive parts, usually having numerical or chronological designations, and intended to be continued indefinitely, whatever its periodicity.

Since 2012 has applied a new classification group - 'Target group - serials'.

**Newspape**r is publication which contains news for current events of special or general interests, the individual parts of which are listed chronologically or numerically and appear usually at least once per week.

**Magazine** is serial, which is published under the same title at regular or irregular intervals, over an indefinite period; individual publications are consecutively numbered or dated.

**Bulletin** is publication (in the form of a pamphlets or leaflet) which contains short formal and official materials (legal, information) relating to the activities of the published organization.

**Periodical** is publication which contains research articles, reports and others and it is published usually on behalf of the scientific institution.

Annual circulation of the periodical is the total quantity of copies of all appearance of one title per one year.

Single circulation is the average circulation from circulations of all appearance of one title per year.
